Torsten Stein is Professor of International, European Union and Comparative Constitutional Law and Director of the Institute of European Studies (Law Department) since 1991. He is a frequent guest lecturer at foreign universities and consultant for governments and NGOs.

He has published several books and numerous articles in his fields of law and is the editor of a European Law Journal and of a series of monographs on European Union and Public International Law.
