University of Macau Dormitory Introduction

University of Macau has East Asia Hall & Block 3 as on-campus student dormitory and rented some apartments at Pak Lok Garden, Hoi Wan Garden & Orchid Tower as off-campus student dormitory.



East Asia Hall

East Asia Hall is a 22-storey building, which includes two separate buildings that are connected by an open plaza. Every two rooms are formed in a suite that shares a common washroom & shower room. Each floor is equipped with a TV room, pantry, washroom, and shower room. 5/F is a recreation area, and 9/F serves as a common floor with study rooms, convenient store, laundry & dormitory service office.



Pak Lok Garden, Hoi Wan Garden & Orchid Tower

Pak Lok Garden, Hoi Wan Garden and Orchid Tower are residential buildings. Pak Lok Garden and Hoi Wan Garden are located nearby the University, while Orchid Tower is located in Macao Peninsula. All locations are convenient for shopping and dining. All the dormitory apartments are furnished with kitchen and washroom. Basic furniture and electrical appliances (such as reading desk, dining table and chairs, refrigerator, air conditioner and water heater) are also provided.
