If you have not taken and passed all the required courses in your curriculum, you will not be able to graduate. For students admitted in 2004 or after, a minimum GPA of 2.0 is required for graduation.

DISTRIBUTION/DIVERSITY (DE) COURSES

- The diversity courses required in the curriculum of FBA students (B1 intake) should be from four **DIFFERENT** major programs outside the student's own major.
- Students **SHOULD NOT** take language course(s) as distribution/diversity course(s).

COURSES WITH YEAR LEVEL HIGHER THAN THE STUDENTS'

All FBA students are **NOT** allowed to take courses with year level more advanced than theirs **OUTSIDE FBA**. For instance, UF1 students are not allowed to take courses coding with 2XX, 3XX and 4XX from other faculties like FSH, FST, FED, FLL and ICMS. Meantime, UF2 students are allowed to take courses coding with 1XX and 2XX, but not 3XX and 4XX from faculties other than FBA.

However, FBA students **ARE** allowed to take courses which are more advanced than their own year level **WITHIN FBA**, subject to eligibility and available quota.

ENGLISH COURSES OFFERED BY ENGLISH LANGUAGE CENTRE (ELC):

If students are not eligible to take the intermediate or higher level English courses (EELC215/216 or EELC131/132 or EELC141/142), they are required to take and pass the lower level English courses (EELC001/002 & EELC011/012) first. The lower level English courses shall not be counted towards graduation requirement and shall not be counted as the non-FBA elective courses.

BUSINESS LAW COURSES:

1. BBEL331 Business Law II is only for Year 3 ACC students (A9 intake).
2. BBEL332 Business Law II is only for students (A9 intake) from GHM, BBA, ELB, GBM, HRM, BEC, BEC in SE, MTG, and MTG in RM in the first semester. FNS students (B0 intake), as well as, FIC and HRM students (A9 intake) should take it in the second semester.

E) COURSES/MAJOR INFORMATION

ACCOUNTING (ACCT) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. GHM and BBA students (B0 intake) have the priority to enroll in ACCT100 Principles of Financial Accounting. The course will be offered to ACC11 students (B1 intake) in the second semester of academic year 2011/2012.
2. ACC and FNS students (B0 intake) have the priority to enroll in ACCT210 Management Accounting I. GHM and FIC students (B0 intake) will take this course in the second semester.
3. ACC students (B0 intake) and FIC students (A9 intake) have the priority to enroll in ACCT211 Intermediate Accounting I.
4. ACCT311 Management Accounting II is for FIC students (A9 intake) only.
5. ACC students (A9 intake) have priority to enroll in ACCT314 Accounting Information Systems.
6. Courses titled ACCT4XX are for AT students (A8 or before intake) only.

2. GAHM303 Quality Service Management is for Year 3 GHM and all FBA non-GHM major students (A9 or after intake).
3. GAHM410 Festival and Event Management is for Year 3 GHM in CH and all FBA non-GAHM major students (A9 or after intake).



- 4. GAMB311 Strategic Management of Gaming Industry is for Year 4 GM and all FBA non-GM major students (A8 or before intake).
- 5. GAMB309 Convention and Exhibition Management is for Year 4 GM and all FBA non-GM major students (A8 or before intake).

MANAGEMENT (MGMT) COURSES / MAJOR:

- 1. MGMT110 Principles of Management is offered for ACC11, FNC11 and HGM11 (B1 intake) students and all retaking students, all Year 1 GBS11 students (B1 intake) will take this course in second semester.
- 2. MGMT220 Business Communications is only offered to BBA students (B0 intake) and all retaking students in this semester.
- 3. MGMT221 Organization Behavior is offered to BBA students (B0 intake) in both semesters. Students who take MGMT221 in first semester will take EBIS200 in second semester, and vice versa.
- 4. MGMT330 Strategic Management is offered to all Year 3 BBA students (A9 intake) in both semesters. Except GBM students (A9 intake), all other BBA students (A9 intake) taking MGMT330 in first semester will take GBMT300 in second semester, and vice versa.
- 5. Students who need MGMT463 Strategic Human Resource Management should take MGMT466 Contemporary Topics in HRM instead. These two courses are equivalent (MGMT463 is not offered).
- 6. Students who need MGMT407 Cultural Influences on Management should take MGMT465 Cross-Cultural Management instead. These two courses are equivalent. (MGMT407 is not offered)
- 7. The following old program courses will not be offered in the first semester of academic year 2011/2012. Students from the old program (A8 or before intake) can take the corresponding new courses, which have been made equivalent to the old program courses, to fulfill their graduation requirement.

INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS (INTL) COURSES / MAJOR:

1. INTL405 International Brand Management is equivalent to MKTG473 Brand Management. Year 4 IB students (A8 or before intake) have to take **MKTG473** instead of INTL405 (INTL405 is not offered in this semester).

GLOBAL BUSINESS MANAGEMENT (GBMT) COURSES/MAJOR:

1. GBMT300 Global Business Environment is offered to all Year 3 FBA students (A9 intake) in both semesters, but **NOT** for GBM students, so GBM students cannot take this course.
2. GBMT301 Introduction to Global Business Management is **ONLY** offered to Year 3 GBM students (A9 intake) in the first semester, but not for non-GBM students, so non-GBM students cannot take this course.
3. GBM students are **NOT** allowed to take GBMT300 as their third year level FBA elective courses.

QUANTITATIVE METHODS AND DECISION SCIENCE COURSES (MSOR/QMDS):

1. QMDS100 Business Mathematics is for HGM11 and GBS11 students (B1 intake), retaking and non-FBA students. ACC11 and FNC11 students (B1 intake) will take this course in the second semester of academic year 2011/2012.



2. QMDS103 Logic and Reasoning is for GHM students only.
3. QMDS200 Statistics and Data Analysis is for ACC students (B0 intake), as well as students retaking it. BBA students (B0 intake) will take the course in the second semester of academic year 2011/2012.
4. QMDS201 Probability and Statistics is for GHM students (B0 intake). It is equivalent to MSOR220 Probability and Statistics.
5. QMDS300 Quantitative Decision Analysis is for ACC, FNS, GHM (A9 intake) and retaking students, as well as FBA students (A8 or before intake) who require MSOR330 and MSOR370 to graduate. BBA students (A9 intake including different majors and specializations) will take this course in second semester.
6. Students who would like to take MSOR380 please enroll in QMDS301 Forecasting Models in Business, the two courses are equivalent.
7. QMDS302 Casino Mathematics is for GHM in GA students (A9 intake) only.
8. QMDS303 Applied Mathematics for Economics is for BEC students (A9 intake), as well as EIF students (A8 or before intake) who have not yet completed MSOR201.
9. MSOR300 Advanced Business Mathematics, QMDS301 Forecasting Models in Business, and QMDS311 Operations Management will be offered in the second semester of academic year 2011/2012.
10. Only 3 units of credit will be granted if students complete incompatible courses in the same group.
