

The Honours College “Macau Tower Team Building Camp” Fully Sponsored by Sociedade de Jogos de Macau, S.A. (SJM) will be Held on Feb 6



The students at the Honours College of the University of Macau are committed to a three-year honours programme with a core focus on leadership development. Among the courses they take, “Development of Leadership Skills” focuses on their development of these skills on campus through small group coaching. In the coming new semester to begin with, a team building camp is arranged at the Macau Tower on Feb 6, 2010, fully sponsored by the Sociedade de Jogos de Macau, S.A. (SJM).

A challenging leadership experience is an integral part of the Honours College course HONR202 “Development of Leadership Skills”. With the generous support of SJM, students will be given the opportunity of enjoying a full-day team building adventure at the Macau Tower. There, they are going to try out the famous thrilling Skywalk X created by AJ Hackett. Students will be standing on 233 meters above ground, strolling around the outer-rim that encircles the Tower, which is just 1.8 meters wide with no handrail! Yet safety is guaranteed by a world-first overhead rail system. They are given the chance to test their nerves, exceed their personal limits and enhance their esprit de corps. The result of such an achievement will be a tremendous boost in self-confidence and a new feeling of invincibility. In addition, they will also test their strength at the Sport Climbing where they could climb 32 meters up the concrete shaft of the tower, probably the world's highest artificial climbing wall providing choices of 3 routes of various difficulties.

Through this one-day activity, students are able to enhance their self-confidence and minimize their fears. At the end of the adventure, they will have formed a stronger bonding as a team and seen Macau from a uniquely different perspective. We also gratefully thank the SJM for supporting our group for a complimentary lunch at the 360° Café where our students could see the magnificent scenery of Macau 55km away.
