"Thoughts on the Design of Hengqin Campus of the University of Macau" Analysis of the Consultation Responses

A survey was carried out to collect opinions of the University of Macau (UM) community members on the "Thoughts on the Design of Hengqin Campus of the University of Macau". The consultation document and the respective questionnaire were distributed by the UM Rector's Office (RTO) through email to all academic and administrative staff as well as students and alumni on May 11 and 12, 2009.

In this survey, the academic and administrative staff and the students had the options to complete the questionnaire online or alternatively to download and return it by email or post after filling it up. To the alumni, only the second participation and submission method was available. As of May 21, 2009, when the survey closed, a total of 548 completed questionnaires were received (Please refer to Table 1). No response rate was calculated due to the fact that the questionnaires were completed online or returned via email or post (12 alumni and 2 academic staff submitted their responses via email), and that there was not a fixed amount of questionnaires distributed.

Respondents were requested to give a grading for the items and sub-items relating to "Guiding Principles and Concepts for Campus Design", "Campus Design" (corresponding to Sections 3 and 4 in the consultation document) and "Overall Satisfaction towards Thoughts on the Design of Hengqin Campus of the University of Macau" respectively. Spaces for writing comments and suggestions were provided in each item and sub-item.

Analysis of the Figures

The grading was based on a 1-10 scale. Average scores obtained for Guiding Principles and Concepts for Campus Design, Campus Design and "Overall Satisfaction towards Thoughts on the Design of Hengqin Campus of the University of Macau" were 6.67, 6.79 and 6.22, respectively. If score 6 and above is considered a reasonable indicator of support, the UM community members are generally holding a positive attitude towards the "Thoughts on the Design of Hengqin Campus of the University of Macau" (please refer to Table 2).

The overall average scores for all the items and sub-items were above 6, and the average scores given by the staff were higher than 7. Students' grading for items and sub-items on "Guiding Principles for Campus Designing" and "Campus Design" was above 6, however it dropped to 5.73 when referring to the last item "General Level of Approval on the Thoughts". Undergraduate students gave a 5.45 score to this last item while grading all other items above 6, which has reflected certain inconsistency. On the other hand, graduate students and alumni showed their support to the new campus design by rating all the items and sub-items above 6 (please refer to Table 2).

A closer examination of the grading revealed some respondents' extreme responses (either the lowest score1 or the highest score10) to all the items and sub-items. Although the reasons for such responses remain unknown, these figures have skewed the data and thus undermined the reliability of the analysis. Moreover, some respondents showed a positive attitude towards almost all the items and sub-items but graded 1, the lowest value, as their general degree of satisfaction with the proposal. Some respondents who gave the lower grading (1-5) made comments on the relocation of the campus rather than campus design, which demonstrated a distraction from the purpose of this consultation. Scores given by these respondents might compromise the reliability of the survey results.

In order to avoid possible inconsistencies caused by the above mentioned issues, figures such as cumulative percentage, median and mode were worked out for further analysis (please refer to Table 3).

(1) Cumulative Percentage(CP)

The CP of the lower degree of support (grading of 1-5) ranged normally from 18% to 36%, while the CP of the higher degree of support (grading of 6-10) reached a scale of generally 64% to 82%, which has highlighted respondents' tendency to endorse the consultation document.

(2) Median

To avoid extreme cases and figures, medians were adopted to measure central tendencies. All the items and sub-items under consultation have scored medians of either 7 or 8.

(*3*) *Mode*

Modes of all the items and sub-items were either 8 or 10.

Analysis of these three indicators suggested that respondents in general have showed support for the "Thoughts on the Design of Hengqin Campus of the University of Macau".

In summary, the analysis on the survey statistics indicated that the UM community members (namely academic and administrative staff, students and alumni) have generally endorsed the "Thoughts" on the Design of Hengqin Campus of the University of Macau".
