LOGISTIC REGRESSION ANALYSIS IN SOCIAL & BEHAVIOR SCIENCE RESEARCH

WORKSHOP

This workshop provides the basic coverage of logistic regression analysis and its application in social and behavior science research. The workshop will focus on the conceptual understanding of logistic regression analysis, and on the practical application of this analytic approach in research. Simple examples will be used for presenting the relevant concepts, and SPSS data examples will be used for illustrating the implementation of this analytical method, and for illustrating the interpretations of the logistic regression analysis results. It is expected that the attendees have the basic command of linear regression analysis, and have the basic knowledge in using SPSS for data treatment and analysis.
